KxRegistration to KxConferencing

KxB&B can only be linked to an event via an advert and **only to take the bedrooms reserved off the event bedrooms.**

The attendees from the web B&B DO NOT fall into KxConferencing but do fall into KxResidential as a reservation.

A reservation code and the event reference number links the advert to the event

The code is sent to the external event organiser to be sent on to possible attendees.
