Some Taxes, but Not All**

Tax Rates and Exemption

When an event or a company is tax exempt, taxes are not charged on any items on the quote/Current charges

However, in some circumstances, some companies might be exempt of some taxes but have to pay others.

Example

Company Blue is exempt for state taxes. But it is not exempt from city sales tax.

In this scenario, just making a company tax exempt will not work.

The company can remain as a tax exempt or tax paying company and in the event, the event can become a tax-exempt event

How to set this up in KxConfiguration

To do this the state and city taxes need to have a status in the tax rate. This needs to show the Kx user what the tax actually is ie Standard GST 20%

Or City Sales Tax 5%
